In moving back towards indoor worship, we are opening the opportunity for parishioners to reserve and purchase flower arrangements to be displayed during Sunday services. These flowers are a beautiful way to commemorate loved ones and to celebrate or give thanks for the blessings of life, friends, and family.

To purchase an altar flower arrangement for Sunday worship, please:

- 1. Print your name next to your preferred date on the flower poster located in the narthex just outside the sanctuary doors.
- 2. Fill out one of the altar flower envelopes (located next to the poster) with any pertinent information, including a color specification, and enclose your payment inside. <u>A typical arrangement costs \$80</u>, but prices may differ for specialized arrangements. Please contact the parish office with any questions regarding this.
- 3. If nobody is in the office, envelopes may be left in the mailbox located outside the parish office doors. Otherwise, envelopes may be left to any administrator of the office.

Sitting just outside the parish office and accepting donations. Doors are open Mon - Fri, 9AM - 12PM. Food items, cleaning, and personal care items needed




VIRTUAL OFFICE HOURS
