But Jesus told his followers that he would have to suffer. They did not believe it. Jesus seemed too strong to suffer. If he suffered, it might mean that he was weak.

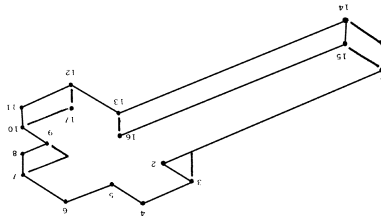

Jesus told his friends, "Not only will I have to suffer, but if you want to be my friends, then you will have to suffer too." Jesus' friends did not like hearing Jesus talk that way. Sometimes you have to suffer when you do God's work.

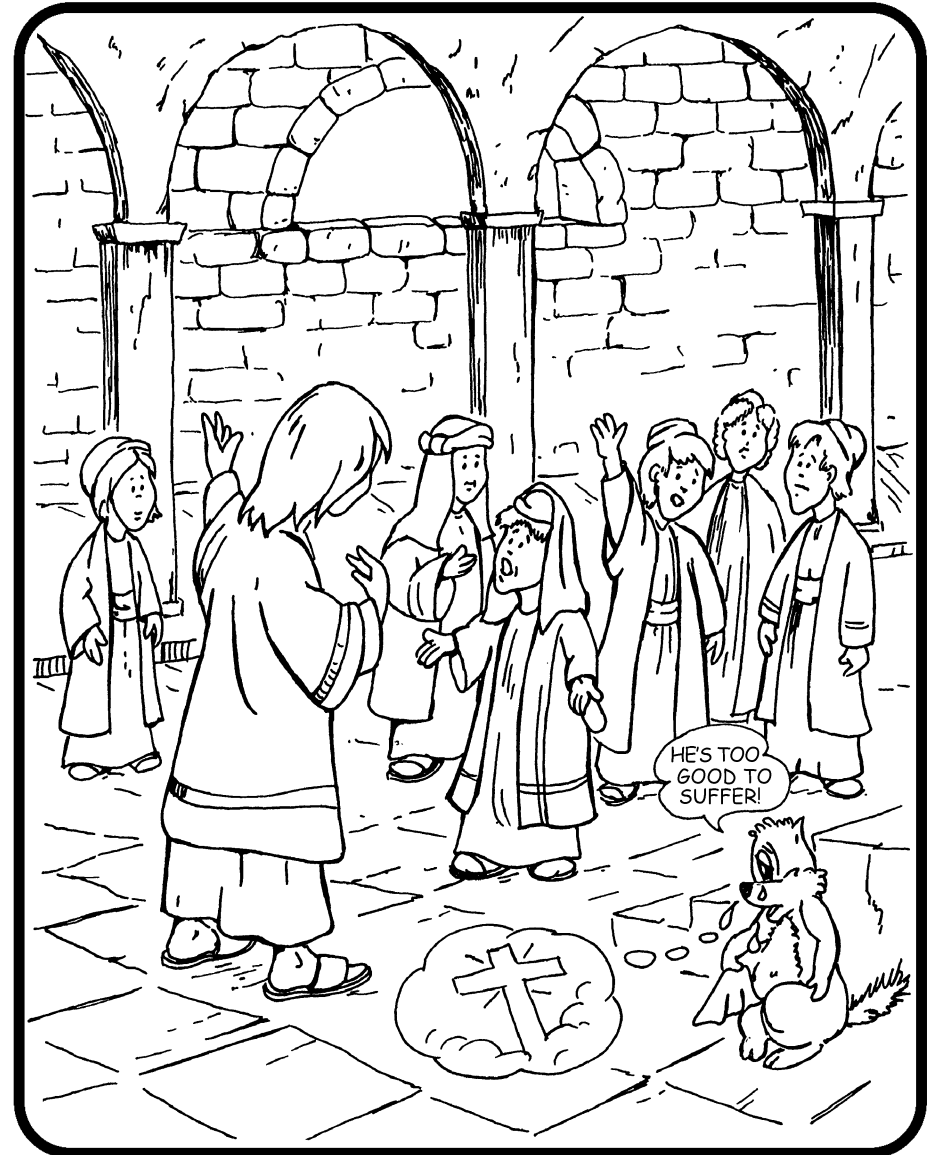
